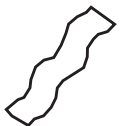
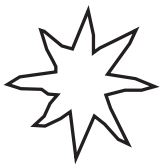

4. Cut the centre line

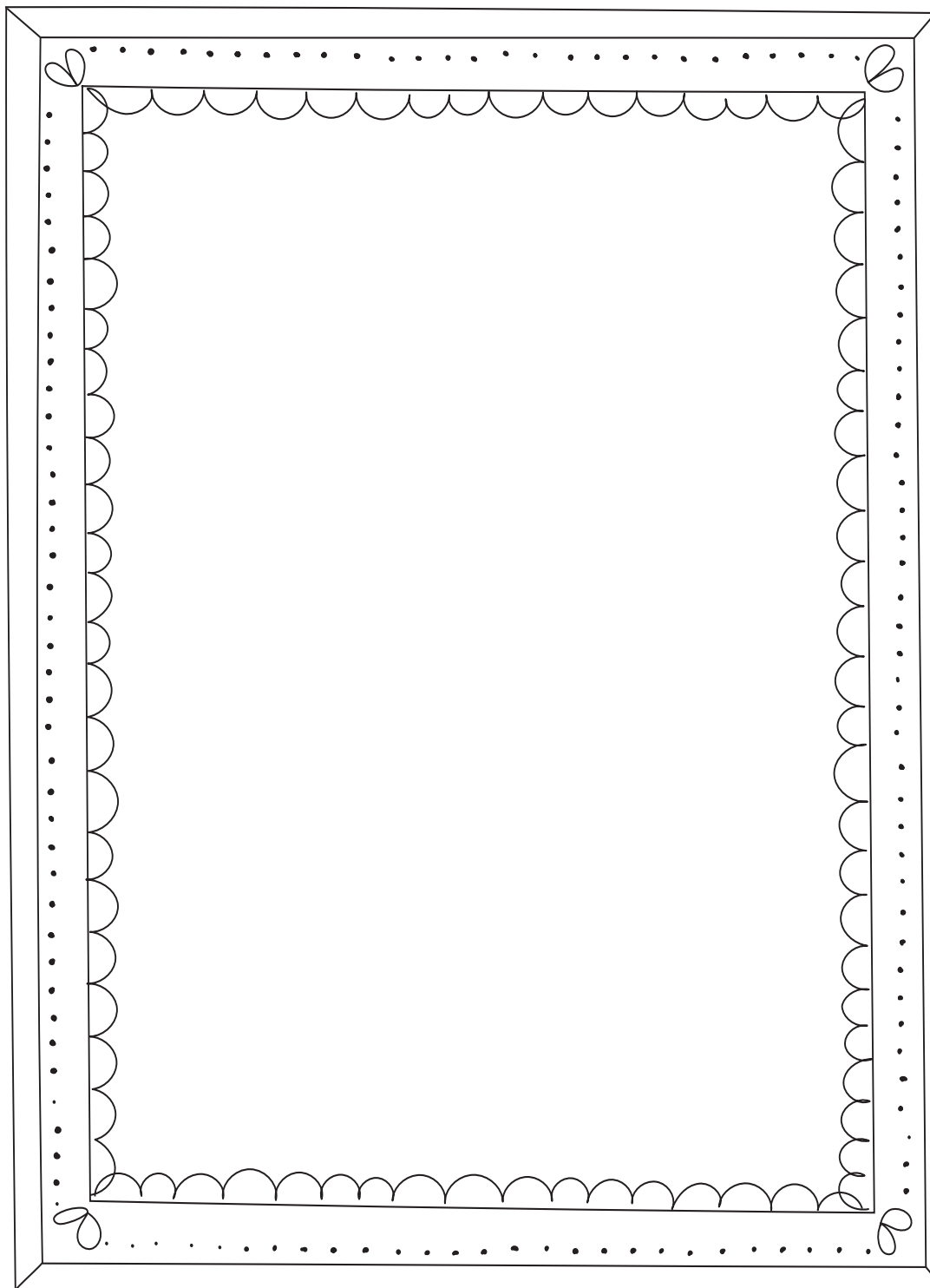
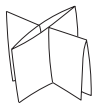
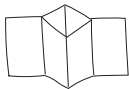
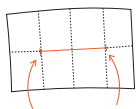
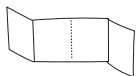
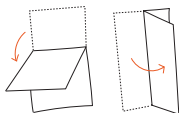
5. Fold your paper in half
