



2021 Who's who portrait prize— conditions of entry

Who's who portrait prize

Geelong Gallery's *Who's who portrait prize* aims to encourage young artists to celebrate a local in their community through portraiture.

Selected entries will be exhibited at Geelong Gallery.

Prizes are awarded in five categories: Kinder to Foundation, Levels 1 to 3, Levels 4 to 6, Levels 7 to 9, Levels 10 to VCE.

A prize is also awarded to the artist whose portrait is nominated best in the *People's choice* category and will be announced on **Wednesday 25 August**.

Each of the winners will receive a creative gift from the Geelong Gallery Store valued at \$50.

Conditions of entry

1. Student/artist may enter one original artwork only.
2. Information on how to enter forms part of the conditions of entry. Entry is deemed acceptance of these conditions.
3. No three-dimensional pieces will be accepted.
4. Entries that are offensive will not be accepted.
5. No late entries will be accepted.
6. The Gallery shall appoint the judging panel that will view all entries that comply with the conditions of entry and select a limited number of works for inclusion in the exhibition. The judging panel reserves the right to exhibit, or not exhibit, any work entered. The judging panel shall solely determine the prize-winning portraits.
7. The judging panel's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. The Gallery reserves the right to exclude works that do not meet the required standard for display.
9. By entering the *Who's who portrait prize* you agree for the artist's work to be used for marketing purposes.
10. Exhibition display: Geelong Gallery reserves the right to convert this exhibition into an online presentation should a physical display not be possible.

Judging criteria

1. Artwork adheres to the terms and conditions of the *2021 Who's who portrait prize*.
2. Student/artists expression of individual artistic intention when creating their portrait.
3. Student/artists ability to explore and manipulate different materials and use multiple techniques when creating their portrait.
4. Student/artists ability to capture the characteristics, personality and/or identity of the sitter.
