Geelong Gallery's volunteer program provides structured shifts for both weekday and weekend volunteer work, allowing individuals the opportunity to work with the creative space of Geelong Gallery. Volunteers are expected to commit a minimum of one shift per month or 12 shifts per year.

Volunteers receive a range of benefits, including complimentary membership, volunteer-only events and resources, and discounts within the Geelong Gallery Store and to select public programs.
