Discover Kate Beynon's self-portrait *With amulets and their shadows* (2017). The artist has painted herself surrounded by hanging personal symbols and objects inspired by the Mexican artist Frida Kahlo.

Each object symbolises a different meaning including, compassion, luck, life and death, identity and hope.

## Create your own self-portrait

Grab some coloured pencils and a mirror to draw your own face.

Consider your pose and setting. Is it a close-up view of your face, or are you including part or all of your body? Will you include a setting that is familiar or imaginary?
