



COVID-19 Safety

Geelong Gallery conditions of entry

- Book a ticket online to visit the Gallery (free).
- Provide your name and contact details when booking or on entry to support contact tracing (anyone booking on behalf of others is required to provide those people's contact details, if requested).
- Arrive for the time you've booked and wait to be checked in by Gallery staff.
- Wear a face covering at all times during your visit
- Bring a credit or debit card for any on-site purchases (we won't be accepting cash).
- Do not bring large bags (you'll have to carry any bag at your side or on your front).
- Don't visit in a large group.
- Don't visit if you're unwell, have experienced cold or flu symptoms in the last 14 days, or have returned from overseas in the last 14 days.
- Consider downloading the COVIDSafe app.

Please note: Visitors who do not comply with these conditions will not be admitted or will be asked to leave to ensure the safety of all.

What we ask of you on your next Gallery visit

- Use the hand-sanitiser provided on arrival.
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow or a tissue, and put the tissue in a bin.
- Cloak your umbrella yourself in the stands provided.
- Wash your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds in our restrooms.
- Keep at least 1.5 metres distance from others at all times.
- Please don't touch the artworks.
- Go to an alternative Gallery space if a particular space has too many people.
- Visitors with access requirements can still use ramps and lifts, and borrow the Gallery's wheelchairs which are sanitised after each use.
- Allow less-mobile visitors to use elevators first, or consider using the stairs.

What we're doing for you

- There are separate entry and exit lanes, floor markings and signage to help visitors maintain safe distances.
- We've provided hand sanitisers at the Gallery entry and at various places throughout the building including the Gallery Store.
- Each Gallery space has its maximum capacity, based on the rule of 1 person per 4 square metres. Please follow instructions from staff.
- All Gallery officers are trained in COVID-safe first aid.
- Gallery seats and ottomans have signage to indicate maximum numbers of people to be seated at any one time.
- We will continue to be guided by the Victorian Government's health guidelines and will provide updates to this information.
- We're cleaning frequently with hospital-grade disinfectants.

Changes to our venue

- Cloaking facilities and all interactive displays will be unavailable.
- No tours or events will be run until further notice.

Ticket FAQs

- There is no limit to how long you can stay at the Gallery—we will monitor venue capacity.
