From Wednesday 11 November, Geelong Gallery is delighted to reopen its doors to the public.

In line with the conditions outlined by the Victorian Government and health authorities, the Gallery's priority will be to keep staff, volunteers, members and visitors safe.

Geelong Gallery Director & CEO, **Jason Smith** said 'Geelong Gallery has implemented venue capacity restrictions in line with Government advice, and as such, we are delighted to be re-opening our doors once more, as we continue to provide enriching, creative experiences for the people of Geelong and beyond.'

'We understand our audiences have changed, and indeed expanded, in the past 7 months. While some people will be keen to engage more closely again with our with our collection and exhibitions we will continue to run a range of programs and online exhibitions for those who would prefer to engage from a distance or who are unable to visit at this time.'

Geelong Gallery will continue to offer our public, learn and access programs online until February 2021 for the safety of our visitors and staff. Volunteers will not return to the Gallery until the new year.

The Gallery's priority is to keep visitors and staff safe and we have reintroduced a number of new measures to keep the community safe detailed in our updated [Conditions of Entry \(click through to read\)](#). Smith said, 'We hope these measures give the community confidence that the Gallery spaces are safe and ready for visitors and prepared in line with museum standards and COVID-19 best practice regulations.'
